



LONDON STUDENT TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES 2018

The Association of London Environmental Health Managers is looking to appoint 4 students who are currently studying for or who have completed the BSc Environmental Health or MSc in Environmental Health.

Applications are invited from students who are undertaking or have the above qualifications, and are looking to complete their Portfolio of Professional Competence and intend to work within local authority enforcement after qualification. Students should be based in or live within easy reach of London.

Alehm is a charity, whose members include all 33 London local authority environmental health teams. As part of this role, Alehm coordinates the technical liaison groups for London, carries out cross borough investigations and projects and works with boroughs to find appropriate short term placements to help students meet their training needs. Alehm appoints students who form a pool of available trainees to take on projects and activities as and when required.

Between 2015 and 2017 Alehm students were involved in FSA funded projects to encourage the display of food hygiene stickers, regional sampling programmes, minute taking for technical groups, as well as being recommended for placement opportunities that arose across the boroughs.

Examples of opportunities likely to be available during 2018/19 are:

- **Paid support for liaison groups, including minute taking, project coordination and research.**
- **Participation in cross borough projects and investigations.**
- **Access to student placements within local authorities.**
- **Paid bursaries for research projects.**
- **Paid work to undertake local borough research.**
- **Potential sponsorship for student's undergraduate/post graduate research projects carried out on behalf of technical groups**

The opportunities will be short term, but varied, and some will be funded with bursary or by other payment arrangements. Where placements are not funded, Alehm will cover travel expenses within London. Each project or activity will be offered independently to suitable students and there will be no obligation on students to take up the opportunities offered.
